Sincil Bank Community Hub opened during December 2018, the team consisting of Paul, Rachel and Michelle are based in the area to ensure the delivery of key projects. These projects include the building of new properties, development of open spaces and improvements to the physical appearance of the area.

Alongside these key projects, the team also provide advice and guidance to members of the community. During the period April 2022 to December 2023, the hub had seven hundred visitors. Advice given includes, signposting to local activities and support services.

Who else works at the Hub?

The team have supported the development of an organisation called Lincoln Embracing All Nations (LEAN). Once a month an immigration advice surgery is held by level two accredited advisors.

February will also see the Hub welcome colleagues from Citizens Advice. A drop in session will take place each Tuesday from the 7th February, contact the team for further information.

Holding a Police surgery are currently being talked about, they are an opportunity to come and talk to them via a drop-in service. More information to follow.


